






How much of the syllabus was covered in the current academic year? 1,520 responses




How the syllabus was covered?




The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as 1,520 responses




Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.






The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.






















What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, PPTs etc. while teaching.
